

A SEAFARING VILLAGE

Climb aboard our historic ships to learn about seafaring during the Age of Sail. Or walk through our seaport town to discover what life was like for people in the 19th century. Learn about the different crafts and trades, such as coopering, carving, printing, and blacksmithing.

A WORKING SHIPYARD

This is where traditional techniques are passed on to the next generation – right in front of your eyes! Watch as expert shipwrights restore and maintain the Museum's vast watercraft collection and other large vessels.

STAR CENTRAL

Learn the secrets of the night sky at one of our Planetarium shows, or let the little ones climb aboard our nautical-themed playscape. The Funk Children's Museum (ages 7 and under) and Home Port (ages 8-12) offer children and families the chance to spend quality time at arts and crafts, games, and more.

GALLERY QUAD

Discover your own story of the sea through the engaging exhibitions on display in the indoor galleries located on the north end of the grounds.

KIDS ACTIVITY ZONE

Fun for all ages. Play a 19th-century game, design and build your own toy boat, or visit the Discovery Barn for a hands-on exploration about the science behind how ships work. Then relax on our village green with a picnic or snack.

RIVER EXPLORATION

Feel the wind in your hair as you head out for your own voyage on the Mystic River. Be your own captain at our boathouse or let us take you.
